

The Morris Canal in Jersey City Past, Present, Future

Though Jersey City spans just three miles from the Hackensack River to the Hudson, the Morris Canal once traced an eight-mile arc through the city, dropping south to Bayonne before swinging north to reach its eastern terminus. Today, more than two miles of that canal corridor has been reclaimed as greenway, with another three miles in various stages of development. Join us at our March Program Meeting as speaker Steve Krinsky presents on Jersey City's canal history and the exciting future of the city's growing Morris Canal Greenway trail system.
